At the end of last school year, LPS sent families a 5 question survey to help us better serve families. survey, responses are important and helpful.

- 1. Were your students' academic needs met while at Learning Prep this year?
- 2. Were your students' social/emotional needs met while at Learning Prep this year?
- 3. Have the Learning Prep staff been supportive to your family?
- 4. How has LPS communicated information with you?
- 5. How likely are you to recommend Learning Prep to another family?

We had 45 families respond and the majority of responses were positive. We value all input and want to know how we can be better. The LPS admin team read all comments and followed up with participating families. We want LPS to work for all of our families. The responses were also presented to the Board of Directors and staff.

Looking Ahead:

We have 127 students enrolled. This number is pretty well divided by grades.

Last year the staffing crisis hit all schools, including LPS. The staff who came on last year have been great additions to our community. To start this school year we only had 2 new staff members!

MTSS Multi Tiered System of Support-

MTSS came from Response To Intervention (RTI)

MTSS is a Massachusetts program in public schools that uses data on how students are responding to interventions.

LPS has adopted MTSS this year, but we have always had elements of MTSS, including small classes and giving students what they need, but we were not always looking at the data systematically to make thoughtful and consistent decisions.

Staff Professional Development is focusing on MTSS this year.
